The application u/s 482 of B.N.S.S. filed on behalf of the petitioners/accused, namely, 1. Ider Ali Khan, 2. Ramjan Khan, 3. Sader Khan, 4. Neshatun Bibi, 5. Kaderun Bibi, 6. Rehena Bibi, 7. Manjur Ali Khan and 8. Sabina Bibi in connection with Onda P.S. Case No. 110/2026 dt. 27.05.2026 u/s. 126(2)/118(1)/118(2)/351(2)/3(5) of B.N.S. is taken up for hearing.

TCR is received. C.D. is also produced.

Heard the Ld. Lawyer for the petitioners/accused namely, 1. Ider Ali Khan, 2. Ramjan Khan, 3. Sader Khan, 4. Neshatun Bibi, 5. Kaderun Bibi, 6. Rehena Bibi, 7. Manjur Ali Khan and 8. Sabina Bibi.

Heard the Ld. Public Prosecutor.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners/accused has submitted that no bail petition is pending before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta.

An affidavit has been filed on behalf of the petitioners/accused swearing that no application u/s 482 of the BNSS has been filed before the Hon'ble Court.

It is found upon perusal of the affidavit, duly furnished on behalf of the petitioners/accused, that no case is pending before the Hon'ble High Court in connection with the present case.

Accused persons /petitioners by filing a petition submits that they have falsely been implicated in this case.

They have also highlighted that the FIR as alleged by the defacto complainant is false, concocted and fabricated.

They also submit that there is no chance of absconsion.

It is also submitted that they undertake to appear before the police or the court, if they are granted relief by way of anticipatory bail.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioners/accused persons submits that there was dispute between parties and case and counter case has been filed by either party.

It is also submitted that one case was also filed against the defacto complainant bearing Onda P.S. case no. 117/2026 dated 04.06.2026.

To substantiate the submission, Ld. Advocate submits documents by way of firisti.

Thus, Ld. Advocate has prayed for anticipatory bail on any terms and condition as this court may deem fit and proper.

It is also undertaken by the Ld. Advocate that the petitioners/accused persons will abide by the terms & conditions imposed by this court.

Ld. Public Prosecutor opposed the prayer for bail and draws attention of the court to the C.D containing statements and injury report.

Perused the formal FIR, L.C.R. and C.D.

Also perused the injury report vis-a-vis the written complaint.

Considered the written complaint of the counter case as placed before me by firisti.

Continuing....

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It is found that there is a specific allegation against the accused/petitioner no. 1. Ider Ali Khan, who alleged to have attacked the defacto complainant with sharp cutting weapon for which injured received injury on the vital part of his body.

I am of the view that custodial detention of the accused persons, except the accused/petitioner no. 1. Ider Ali Khan, is not required for the sake of investigation

Justice could be substantiated if the accused persons be released on bail subject to terms and conditions.

So far the accused/petitioner no. 1. Ider Ali Khan is concerned, there is specific allegation against him in the FIR and that is apparently support by injury report.

I am inclined to grant relief by way of anticipatory bail to the **accused persons/petitioners no. 2 to 8**, except accused/petitioner no. 1. Ider Ali Khan.

Hence,

Ordered

that prayer for anticipatory bail is allowed on condition.

In the event of arrest, petitioners/accused shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 4,000/- each with two registered sureties of Rs. 2,000/- each subject to the satisfaction of Ld. CJM, Bankura, on condition that after release on bail, they shall strictly comply with the provision u/s 482(2) of B.N.S.S. and with a condition to surrender before Ld. CJM, Bankura within 15 days from the date of this order for regular bail which shall be considered by Ld. CJM, Bankura u/s 480 of B.N.S.S. on further condition:

1. that the petitioners/accused shall cooperate with the investigation and
2. petitioners/accused no. **2, 3 and 7** shall meet the I.O. once a fortnight and petitioners/accused no. **4, 5, 6 and 8** shall meet the as and when called for till submission of report in final form and
3. shall not tamper the evidence or hamper the witnesses and
4. shall not threat the defacto complainant or witnesses in any manner whatsoever and
5. shall not create hindrance during investigation.

Anticipatory bail prayer with regard to accused/petitioner no. 1. Ider Ali Khan is considered and rejected.

Return the C.D.

The Criminal Misc. Application is thus disposed of.
