Today is fixed for hearing the bail petition of Prasenjit Mondal filed on 29-11-2022.

Ld advocate on behalf of accused has submitted that the accused person is languishing in judicial since long and has prayed for bail.

Ld advocate on behalf of the prosecution has raised objection in respect of the bail petition.

On perusal of the record it appears that the materials on record are sufficient to prima facie hold that there is reasonable ground to believe that the accused person was involved in the crime . The nature and gravity of the offence is serious in nature .This court is of the view that there is every possibility that the accused person may flee or attempt to delay the trial if released on bail . This court is of the view that there is every possibility of justice being thwarted by granting bail .

The nature and gravity of the offence is serious in nature.

Considering all, this court is not inclined to enlarge the accused on bail .

So, prayer for bail of accused Prasenjit Mondal is rejected .
