

Order No. 16

Today is fixed for appearance, production and hearing of bail petition dated 16.05.2023.

Ld. Advocate for the accused is present.

No step has been taken by other accused persons who are on bail.

No adverse order is passed on the prayer of the Advocates' Bar Association, Bankura dated 08.05.2023.

Ld. PP is present.

The bail petition is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the one of the accused persons namely Pankaj Das prays for bail. Ld. Advocate further submits that the above named accused is detained in custody since 25.04.2023 and that the other accused persons are on bail.

Heard the learned advocate for the petitioner and also the learned public prosecutor.

The learned P.P. has raised objection against the bail prayer.

Perused the materials in the CD. Considered the submission from both sides.

It appears from the record that the present accused petitioner is in custody since 25.04.2023 and that the charge sheet has already been submitted in the instant case.

Considering the facts and circumstances and considering the period of detention and that the charge sheet has been submitted, I am inclined to allow the prayer for bail.

Accordingly, the bail application is allowed.

The accused Pankaj Das may find bail of Rs. 2,000/- with two sureties of Rs. 1,000/- each subject to satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bankura on condition and on further condition that he will not influence any witness or tamper any evidence and that he will be present in Court on every date of hearing, failing which necessary order will be passed.
