The record is put up today on the basis of put up petition.

It is submitted by the Ld. Lawyer on behalf of the plaintiff / Revisionist that there is an urgency in the matter and the stay application filed with the revision is required to be heard to avoid multiplicity of litigation.

In the light of the submission, the application for stay is taken up for consideration.

The Ld. Lawyer while drawing the attention of the Court to Order no.36 dated 08.07.2026 submits that the Ld. Court of Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Bankura passed an order which is in contradiction to the observation made by the Court on 06.12.2022, wherein the Ld. Court passed an order of injunction wherein the parties were directed to maintain status quo.

The Ld. Lawyer on behalf of the plaintiff / revisionist while drawing the attention of the Court to Order no.10 dated 06.12.2022 and highlighted that the Court passed an order directing the parties to maintain the status quo till disposal of the suit.

Subsequently, the Court while considering an application filed by the Defendant, allowed the application and paved way for construction of the house vide Order no.36 dated 08.07.2026.

It is agitated by the Ld. Lawyer of the Plaintiff that the order dated 08.07.2026, as passed, is self contradictory and will invite multiplicity of proceeding.

It is also submitted that the Court passed an order of injunction directing the parties to maintain the status quo and subsequently, granted permission to make construction.

Perused the impugned order.

On the perusal of the stay petition duly supported by an affidavit, I am of the view that there is an element of urgency. The delay in passing stay order will invite multiplicity of proceeding. Keeping into considering the element of urgency, I feel an interim stay will arrest multiplicity of proceeding.

Hence, to evaluate and appreciate the core area of dispute, the opposite parties are also required to be heard and LCR is required to be looked into.

There shall be interim stay to the order dated 08.07.2026 till 23.07.2026.

The Plaintiff is directed to take steps upon the Opposite Party / Defendant at once.
