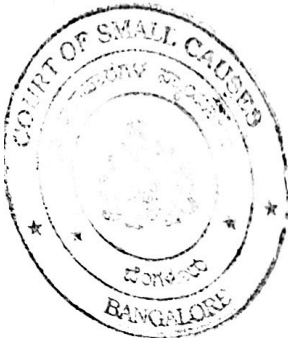

ORDER

The claim petition filed by the claimants U/Sec.166 of MV Act is allowed in part, with costs as under:

The claimants are entitled for compensation of **Rs.19,22,400/- (Rupees Nineteen Lakhs Twenty Two Thousand Four Hundred Only)** with interest at the rate of 6% per annum, from the date of petition to till it's deposit.

The respondents are jointly and severally liable to pay said compensation. However, respondent No.1 being insurer is directed to deposit said compensation amount within the time stipulated U/Sec.168(3) of M V Act.

Claimant No.1 being wife, claimant No.2 being major daughter and claimant No.3 being age old mother of deceased are entitled to share the compensation in the ratio of 60:20:20. In the share of claimant No.1, 70% shall be released in her favour and remaining 30% shall



be deposited in fixed nationalized bank for a petitioner claimant No.2 and 3 shall be Advocate's fee is All the interest stand disposed

Advocate's fee is fixed at Rs.1,000/-.

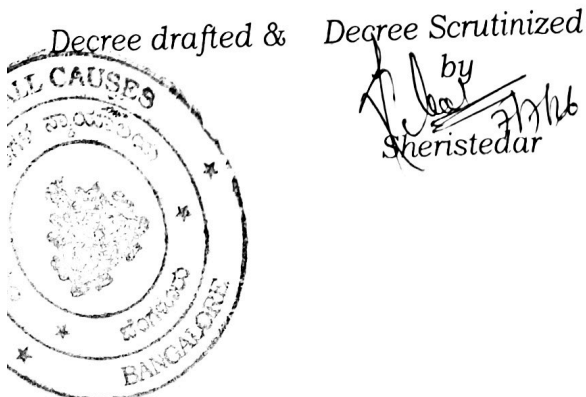
