CHARGE WITH ONE HEAD
[No. XXVIII (I), SCHEDULE V, Act V, 1898]
(Sections 221, 222, 223, Code of Criminal Procedure)

(1) Name and office of Magistrate & Court. I, (1) Deb Kumar Goswami
Judge, Special Court, Bankura
(Under the Electricity Act),

(2) Name of accused hereby charge you (2) – Avijit Bagdi
as follows :-

That on 06.09.2019 in between 11:15 Hrs. and 12:15 Hrs. Electricity Authority of Onda CCC inspected your domestic premises situated at Vill. Singhati, PO Ramsagar, PS Onda, Dist. Bankura and it was detected that you were committing theft of electricity by direct hooking from nearby LTOH line of WBSEDCL for domestic purpose and thereby you have committed an offence punishable U/s 135(1)(a) of the Electricity Act, 2003 as Amended in 2007.

And within (4) the cognizance of the Special Court, Bankura (Under the Electricity Act).

And I hereby direct that you be tried by the said Special Court.

The contents of the above-framed charge are read over and explained to the accused person in Bengali to which she pleads not guilty and claims to be tried by saying “Nirdosh, bichar chai”.
