Reply filed by the IO. Be taken on record.

It is submitted by counsel for the accused that accused is in J/C since 16.12.2025 and has been falsely implicated in the present matter. It is further submitted that custodial interrogation of accused is not required and accused is ready to abide by the terms and conditions, if any, imposed by this Court. It is further argued that charge-sheet has already been filed in the present matter and, therefore, accused may be released on bail.

On the other hand, Ld. APP for the State along with IO have opposed the bail application on the ground that 19 stickers have been allegedly recovered from the possession of the present applicant / accused Zeeshan. It is further argued that there are multiple financial transactions between accused / applicant and co-accused Jeeshan Ali (main accused). It is further argued that the allegations leveled against the applicant / accused are serious in nature and accused might jump the bail, if in case granted and, therefore, ought not to be released on bail.

Submissions heard. Record perused.

No further custodial interrogation has been prayed for by the IO. Although, charge-sheet has been filed, however, trial is likely to take time. Accused has already spent more than a month in custody. As trial is likely to take time and there appears to be no requirement of accused for any further custodial interrogation, no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the applicant/accused behind bars. In view of the same, present bail application is **allowed**. Without expression of any opinion on the merits of the case, present application is disposed off with the direction that applicant/accused namely **Zeeshan** be released on bail on furnishing personal bond in the sum of **Rs.50,000/- (Fifty Thousand)** with one surety in the like amount. Accused is directed to appear before the Court on each date of hearing and shall not tamper with the evidence or attempt to influence witnesses. With these directions, bail application stands disposed off.

Application stands disposed off.
