This is an application for grant of bail to the accused/applicant Raj Kumar filed on behalf of the applicant/accused.

Present: Mr. Sandeep Kumar Bhati, Ld. APP for the state.
Ld. Counsel for the accused/applicant.

Reply to bail application has been filed by the IO.

Vide this order, I shall dispose off bail application of present accused u/s 480 BNSS.

I have perused the bail application and reply filed by the IO.

Ld. Counsel for the accused has submitted that accused is in J/C since 03.12.2025 and has been falsely implicated in the present case. He further submits that investigation has been completed and nothing has been recovered from the possession of the applicant. That no purpose would be served by keeping him in JC any further.

IO submits that matter pertaining to house theft and case property including jewellery and cash amount. Co-accused Kuldeep and Vinod Kumar Soni are still absconding. Accused has been seen in the CCTV footage along with co-accused persons.

On the other hand Ld. APP for the state has opposed the same on the ground that allegations against the accused are

serious in nature and there is also a possibility of him absconding. It is further submitted that there is also strong possibility of threatening the complainant.

Arguments heard. Record perused.

Considering the report of the IO, looking at the gravity of the offence, the possibility of absconding and the fact that possibility of threatening the complainant cannot be ruled out, I am not inclined to grant him bail.

Accordingly, the bail application stands dismissed.
