Later on 16.09.2022	<i>Spl Judge Ex. I I</i> <i>The I.O. of this Case has forwardad the accused Akhilesh Kumar age-25yrs. S/o-Shivmuni Singh Vill-Badhupar P.S.-Mohaniya,Dist-Kaimur with Arresting cum forwarding memo,and medical certificate of accused under proper escort. On query by the Court accused did not complain any misbehave against the police personnel.He further added that he will appoint his legal counsel at his own cost and level. Accused also stated that the arresting information has been given to their family member.Accused person stated to plead guilty voluntarily .Hence proper ordar passed in this point.</i> <i>Spl.PP has not oppossed to said prayer. Heard,both side.In the light of aforesaid pryer form VI (A) as prescribed under rule 18 of Bihar prohibition and excise rule 2022 has been furnished and accused person having gone through it put his signature/L.T.I. on it.On the basis of form VI (A) furnished by police officer/excise officer proceeding as laid down in form VII has been adopted by this court and accused person is found guilty U/S 37of Bihar prohibition and excise act. During the course of hearing it has been submited on behalf of accused person that proper order be passed sympathetically. Considering upon the facts / circumstances and having considered rule 18(A)(6) and 18(3) of Bihar prohibition and excise act 2022 convicted accused namely Akhilesh Kumar is sentenced to pay fine Rs,2500/ and in defaul of payment of fine he will undergo SI for 30 days.</i> <i>(dictated)</i> <i>spl.judge Ex.
