

Order No. 14

The record is taken up for hearing bail petition filed on behalf of the accused Dhirendranath Bauri. The accused persons namely, Biswanath Banerjee and Mithu Bauri are present by filing hazira. Rest 2 accd persons are produced through V/C.

Ld Spl P.P., and the ld defence counsel both are present.

The notice has been issued to the complainant of this case and the S/R of notice returned with the report that the complainant refused to receive the notice. Let the report of SI Biplab Santra of Chhatna PS dated 17.01.26 be kept with the record.

Ld defence counsel submitted that three witnesses including complainant have been examined in this case and the accused is in custody for about 400 days. It is further submitted that the accused is the father of the principal accused and he is the only bread earner of his family and considering his detention, he may be released on bail. It is next submitted that other two accused persons are on bail and there is no adverse report against them and they are appearing on each and every date of hearing.

Ld Spl P.P. raised objection against the bail prayer and submitted that the local witnesses have not yet been examined and if the accused is released on bail, there is a chance of threatening of witnesses and tampering of evidence.

Heard both sides. Perused the record. The accused is the father of the principal accused and the complicity of the accused is transpired. Now, considering the afore, the prayer for bail of the accused is rejected.

Prosecution is directed to produce the witnesses on the date fixed.
