

Order No. 16
dated 20.01.25.

The bail petition filed on 15.01.25 on behalf of the accused Biswanath Banerjee is taken up for hearing.

Ld advocate for the accused Biswanath Banerjee argued that the accused is a village doctor and he only prescribed some medicines to the victim since deceased while she was suffering from vomiting and loose motion and thereafter, when her physical condition was deteriorated, she was referred to BSMCH, Bankura. It is next argued that the accused has registered number for medical practice and that is not a fake. It is further argued that the charge sheet has been filed in the mean time. So, further detention of the accused is not necessary and prays for bail.

Ld Spl P.P. in charge raised objection against the bail prayer and submitted that charge sheet has been filed in this case by the IO and there is a chance of tampering evidence. Ld Spl P.P. in charge further submitted that in the opinion of CMOH, Bankura, the AMRC is not recognized by the West Bengal Medical Council.

Heard both sides. Perused the statements of the witnesses and other documents collected by the IO. It appears that the victim since deceased was produced before the doctor of BSMCH, Bankura and she was declared as brought dead.

Now, considering the materials in the CD, the prayer for bail of the accused person stands rejected and he is remanded to j/c till date.
