Ordered

that all the 04 accused persons, namely, Jhantu Bag, Ghanashyam Bag @ Shyamsundar Bag, Kajal Bag and Mamata Bag are found not guilty of the Charges U/S 376/ 379/34 of the IPC and they are hereby acquitted from this case u/s 235(1) of the Cr.P.C./258(1) of the BNSS.

The accused persons shall remain on the same bail bonds which shall be in force for six months for their appearance before the higher court, in case of appeal being preferred, if any, against this judgement and in case of their failure to appear before the appellate court, the bonds shall be forfeited and the procedure u/s 446 Cr. P.C shall follow.

Be it mentioned here that the defacto complainant has the right to prefer an appeal under proviso to Section 372 of the Cr.PC and if necessary, to avail free legal assistance through the DLSA, Bankura or any other concerned Legal Services Authority.

Let a copy of this judgment be forwarded to the District Magistrate and the DLSA, Bankura for due intimation to the victim as defined U/S 2(wa) of the Cr PC.
