In pursuance of the order passed by Ld. Predecessor of the Court while entertaining the appeal u/s.138 N.I. Act, the appellant Khazanchi deposited an FDR to the tune of Rs.5,50,662/-. Vide order dated 07.11.2025, Ld. Predecessor of the court, the then Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge (NW) upheld the impugned sentence order dated 18.01.2025 passed by Ld. JMFC-04. The applicant herein preferred a criminal revision petition against the aforesaid order, after having settled the matter amicably. Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide order dated 17.11.2025 directed that the FDR in the sum of Rs.5,50,662/- be released in favour of the petitioner in terms of the memorandum of settlement dated 10.11.2025. The appellant court has further been directed to release the amount deposited by the petitioner in his favour alongwith any accrued interest.

SPA Anup Kumar for the respondent Parshotam Dass submits that he has no objection if the FDR is released in favour of the petitioner. Let the statement of SPA Anup Kumar be recorded on oath.
