Today is fixed for admission hearing.

This is an appeal u/s. 415 BNSS against the order of conviction dtd. 31.01.2026 passed in connection with Complaint Case No. 121C / 2002 by the Ld. Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bishnupur, Bankura.

The Ld. Trial Magistrate vide judgment dtd. 31.01.2026 had found appellant guilty of the offence punishable u/s. 16(1)(a)(i) PFA Act 1954 and has sentenced him by order dtd. 31.01.2026 to suffer SI for six months and with fine of Rs.10,000/- for the offence punishable u/s. 16(1)(a)(i) PFA Act 1954 and has also sentenced to suffer SI for one month in default of the payment of the fine.

The appellant being aggrieved and dissatisfied with the above judgment and order of sentence has preferred the present appeal and has prayed for suspension of the execution of his sentence.

I have heard the Ld. Counsel for the appellant who submitted that the impugned judgment suffers from irregularities as the Ld. Trial court has failed to appreciate the evidence on record and wrongly held the accused guilty of the offence punishable under above section. I have gone through the memo of appeal and certified copy of the impugned judgment. I find that there is arguable case in favour of the appellant and interference by this court may be required. Accordingly, the appeal is admitted.

The appellant is already on bail and he has been sentenced to suffer SI for six months only. Considering the period of his sentence and also considering that the appeal has been admitted on the ground that interference by this court in the impugned judgment may be required, the execution of the above sentence dtd. 31.01.2026 of the appellant shall remain be suspended till the disposal of the appeal or until further order whichever is earlier.

Call for the TCR from the Court of Ld. ACJM, Bishnupur, Bankura.

Issue notice upon the State Respondent. Appellant is directed to file the requisites at once.
