Today is fixed for ex-parte hearing.

The petitioner is present by filing hazira. One petition has been filed on behalf of the respondent for vacating the order of ex-parte hearing. The copy of the petition has been served upon the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner.

Heard the Ld. Advocate for the respondent who submitted that the respondent Akhilesh Biswas is now detained in Midnapore Central Correctional Home as he is undergoing the term of imprisonment imposed upon him in connection with a POCSO Case and hence he could not appear before this court immediately on receipt of summons and hence the case was fixed for ex-parte hearing. It is also submitted that on prayer of the said respondent, the present Ld. Advocate has been appointed on his behalf by SDLSC, Bishnupur. The Ld. Counsel further submitted that the respondent want to contest this case and in order to enable him to do so, the order of ex-parte hearing of the suit should be set aside and he should be given an opportunity to file the WS.

No objection has been raised from the side of the petitioner. Accordingly, the prayer for vacating the order of ex-parte hearing of the suit stands vacated on consent. The respondent is given the liberty to file his WS by the next date positively.
