Order No. 04 dtd. 18.11.2025

Today is fixed for hearing of a petition dtd. 29.08.2025 filed by OP No.1 ie Insurance Co. Both parties are present. The petition is taken up for hearing.

The Ld. Counsel appearing for the OP No.1 Insurance Co. has submitted that the present case is not maintainable and for that reason the instant petition has been filed. It is submitted that the present case has been filed for the compensation of the injury of the victim on account of an accident involving motor vehicle but the said injured has not herself filed the petition rather it has been filed by her husband, which is not permissible in law. It has been further submitted that the instant claim petition is incomplete as the claimant has not filled up all 23 columns. It is also submitted that there is no FIR in respect of the alleged incident.

The Ld. Counsel appearing for the petitioner claimant submitted that the injured lady is unable to move and hence this case has been filed on behalf by her husband. The Ld. Counsel also submitted that in the claim petition all the necessary particulars have been provided and all 23 columns are not necessary to be filled up by this petitioner. He further submitted that FIR in respect of the alleged incident has been lodged on 19.12.2023 and details thereof has been provided in the claim petition. He has made prayer to submit the certified copies of the FIR and CS of that case. The Ld. Counsel is at liberty to file the same.

I have heard both parties and shall pass order on 28.11.2025.
