

GR 1202 of 2025

Order dated 11-06-2026

Today is fixed for appearance, production and commitment positively.

CS accused no. 4 Badshah Khan @ Kalo Motu, 6 Samrat Khan @ Bapi, 7 Sk. Sanjib, 8 Hakim Sekh are in custody and they are produced before this Court.

CS accused no. 1 Hasim Sekh , 2 Ibrahim Sekh , 3 Nasim Sekh , 5 Manbodh Khan,, 10 Wasim @ Saheb Sekh, 11 Naju Khan are present by filing hazira.

CS accused no. 9 Samim Sekh and 12 Najemul @ Najir Khan are absconding and both are filed for present vide order dated 05-02-2026.

Ld. Advocate for the de facto is present.

Ld. Advocate files a petition for waiving of condition imposed upon CS accused no. 10 and 11 vide order dated 21.04.2026 by Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Bishnupur, Bankura while allowing the bail application under S. 483 of BNSS. The condition being “ that they shall meet the O.C Sonamukhi PS once in every week and shall not enter into the village Chokai until further order by jurisdictional Court”.

Ld. Advocate further submits that Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Bishnupur vide order no. 03 dated 21.05.2026 while disposing the application of the same two accused persons for waiver of condition in the above mentioned bail order directed “ the accused petitioner is directed to approach before the jurisdictional Court I.e ACJM, Bishnupur for waiver of condition of bail. If any such application is filed before the Ld. ACJM, Bishnupur, the Ld. Court is requested to consider the same as per law .”

Therefore considering the petition and submission of the Ld. Advocate alongwith the order of Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Bishnupur dated 21.04.2026 & 21.05.2026, investigation being complete on submission of charge sheets , I find no hindrance in allowing the petition for waiving the condition imposed and accordingly the prayer is considered and allowed.

The case is taken up for commitment.

Ld. Advocate for the accused persons are present before this Court.

The Ld. APP for the State is present.

Now, the record is taken up for commitment.

Copy had been served on the accused persons.

Charge sheet had been submitted and cognizance has been taken against the accused person for offence punishable **u/s 126(2)/103(1)/61(2) of the BNS.**

The offence u/s. **109 of the BNS** falls within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Ld. Sessions Judge. Hence the case be committed to the Court of the Ld. Additional Sessions Judge for trial in view of Section **232 of the BNSS.**

Ld. Advocate for the accused persons **Hasim Sekh , Ibrahim Sekh , Nasim Sekh , Manbodh Khan, Wasim @ Saheb Sekh and Naju Khan** has filed a petition with prayer to allow the accused persons to remain on same bail and to appear before the court of the Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Bishnupur instead of their production.

The accused persons are hereby directed to appear before the Court of the Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Bishnupur on **25-06-2026** positively.

The Superintendent of the concerned Correctional Home where the accused persons **Badshah Khan @ Kalo Motu, Samrat Khan @ Bapi, Sk. Sanjib and Hakim Sekh** are presently detained is hereby directed to produce the accused persons before the Court of the Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Bishnupur physically on **25-06-2026.**
