1. The present application has been moved U/s 482 of BNSS seeking grant of anticipatory bail for applicant **Vikash**, as police officials from PS Khajuri Khas are repeatedly visiting his residence but are not disclosing the allegations against him. Therefore, applicant is under an apprehension that he might be arrested by them. Hence, the present application has been moved.
2. Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused has submitted that similar application is neither pending nor has been recently dismissed by any higher court.
3. Reply was filed on LDOH. Copy stands supplied.
4. The reply filed by the IO says that a case FIR No-157/2026, PS- Khajuri Khas registered U/s 115(2)/126(2)/351(2) r/w 3(5) of BNS has been registered against the applicant/accused and IO had tried to contact him in relation to the inquiry in the aforesaid case.
5. So, as per the reply filed by the IO, all the offences registered against the applicant/accused are bailable in nature.
6. Since, all the offences are bailable in nature and there is no apprehension of arrest of applicant/accused in this case, the present application stands **dismissed being infructuous**.

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7. However, it is clarified that in case any non-bailable section is added in the FIR, the IO shall give a proper notice to the applicant/accused before taking any coercive steps, in case, such coercive steps are required.

8. Application stands disposed of.

9. Copy of this order be given dasti.
