This is the application filed by the Decree Holder for issuance of attachment warrant of movable property against Judgment Debtors for recovery of decretal amount.

2] It is contended by the Decree Holder that the notices were served on Judgment Debtors, however, they failed to deposit the decretal amount of Rs.16,09,709.81/-. Therefore, it is prayed that order of attachment of the property be issued against the Judgment Debtors.
