Today is fixed for Plea.

Accused person (1) on court bail is present.

He has filed a petition pleading guilty of the charge leveled against him.

The record is taken up for plea. Perused the documents on record. Considered.

Accused is examined u/s 251 Cr.pc. The substance of accusation u/s 46A(c) of Bengal Excise Act is read over and explained to the accused in Bengali to which he pleaded guilty and prayed for mercy.

I am satisfied that the accused voluntarily pleaded guilty of the offense.

He is cautioned in open Court regarding the offense committed.

The accused has also filed a petition for leniency on the ground that he is a very poor, and sick person. Thus, he prayed for leniency of sentence. Considered.

It appears that the accused person is a first-time offender and considering his petition for leniency on affidavit as aforesaid, I am inclined to take lenient view against him.

Hence, he is convicted on the basis of his guilty plea.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED

that the sole accused person found guilty of the offence punishable u/s 46A(c) of Bengal Excise Act and sentenced to imprisonment till the rising of this Court and he is also sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 1650/- i.d. SI for 10 days.

The sentence of imprisonment shall run concurrently in case of default of payment of fine.

The instant case is thus disposed of. Note the same in relevant register.
