Now it is 11.30 A.M noe appears on behalf of the defendants, on repeated out side calls Short pass over is given for the sake of the convenience of the parties. Record is again taken up at 01.35 P.M on repeated out side calls no step is taken up by the defendants. We have been circulated by a notification dated- 05.03.2022 of the Hon'ble High court Calcutta vide no.1282 RG. By which we have been directed to reward back to the physical mode as was prevalent when the situation was normal with the exception that the virtual mode shall also be available to the senior lawyers with co-morbidities or other problems. Considering the situation defendants are hereby directed to file a show-cause as to why the petition Under order 39 Rule 4 of the defendant shall not be rejected.
