It further appears defendant nos. 1, 10, 12, 13, 15, 16, 17, 20 and 29 have prayed for time for filing W/S in the instant suit on the ground stated therein. Let the prayer for time for filing W/S be allowed.

To 21.09.22 for hearing of the injunction petition. Objection, if any, in the meantime and also filing W/O, W/S also by the above mentioned defendants.

Plaintiff files track report from where it appears that the summons have already beens served upon rest defendants as such the suit shall run ex-parte against defendant nos. 2 to 9, 11, 14,18, 19, 21 to 28, 30, 31 and 32.
