ORDER

1. The accused No.1 to 7 are present and they are examined under section 274 BNSS. The substance of accusation for the offence under section 194(2) BNS is read over and explained to them in vernacular language for which they voluntarily pleaded guilty for the offence under section 194(2) BNS. To ascertain the voluntariness of the accused No.1 to 7 in admitting their guilt for the offence under section 194(2) BNS, this court explained A1 to A7 as to consequences of their admission, for which they affirmatively stated that they are voluntarily pleading guilty.

2. In the result, A1 to A7 are found guilty for the offence under section 194(2) BNS and he is convicted under section 252 Cr.P.C. With regard to quantum of sentence A1 to A7 requested to take lenient view. Considering the nature of offence and submission of A1 to A7 and they are sentenced to pay fine of Rs.1,000/- each for the offence under section 194(2) BNS. In default to payment of fine, they shall undergo simple imprisonment for a period of 2 days each. All sentences shall run concurrently. The unmarked property if any shall be disposed after expiry of appeal time or appeal time is over. The right of appeal is intimated to A1 to A7.
