= J U D G M E N T =
(Delivered on 12th Day of November, 2022)

1. The accused stands prosecuted for the offence punishable under section 283 of Indian Penal Code. The particulars of offence are read over and explained to the accused. He pleaded guilty for the same and by giving pursis at Exh. 02 prayed for mercy.
2. The only question therefore arise before me :
 - a) Whether accused pleaded guilty voluntarily ?
 - b) Whether leniency be shown to him ?
3. I answer these points in the affirmative for following reasons :

4. The accused voluntarily pleaded guilty to the charge by his pursis at Exh. 02. Considering plea of accused and his pursis at Exh. 02, I think it is voluntarily made and hence, I accept plea of accused being voluntarily. Accused submitted that this is his first offence, of which now he is repenting upon his act, and hence, lenient view be taken while passing sentence. Thus, considering facts and circumstances of case, nature of offence, I take the lenient view and proceed to pass following order.

Accused **Ashok Balkrushan Chaudhary**, is convicted of the offence punishable under section 283 of Indian Penal Code vide section 252 of Criminal Procedure Code and sentenced to pay fine of Rs. 200/- (Two Hundred Rupees) i/d to suffer S.I. for two days.
