State Vs. Paran Tudu

Today is fixed for hearing of the bail petition dated 17.11.2025 praying for bail of the accused Sri Paran Tudu.

Ld. Advocate for the accused moves the instant petition.

Ld. P.P.-in-charge is present before the Court.

It is submitted that neither any bail application U/s 483 of the B.N.S.S is filed before the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta or before the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

It is also submitted on behalf of the accused that previously no prayer for bail of the accused Sri Paran Tudu, was rejected by the Hon'ble High Court or any other higher forum.

Ld. Advocate for the accused submits inter alia that no specific date of commission of offence is mentioned by the de facto complainant.

It is also submitted that the relation between the victim and the accused was at that time of the incident was for two years.

It is further submitted that the accused is a married person.

Ld. Defence Counsel submits that the accused suffered sufficient custody and by detaining him further, no purpose of the prosecution will be served and so that the accused should be enlarged on bail in any term and condition as per the discretion of the Court.

On the other hand, Ld. P.P.-in-charge raises objection submitting inter alia that the accused by promising to marry her established physical relation with the victim.

It is also submitted that by promising her to marry, he raped her on repeated occasions and when the victim became pregnant, he refused to marry her.

It is further submitted that different pages of the C.D. including the page nos.161, 162 etc. contain direct incriminating materials against the accused.

Ld. P.P.-in-charge ultimately submits that considering the nature and gravity of the allegation and also considering social impact of the instant case, prayer for bail of the accused should be rejected.

Considering the facts and circumstances, materials in the C.D., submissions of the respective parties, nature and gravity of the allegation, social impact of the allegation and ultimately taking into account the interest of justice from wider point of view, this Court is not inclined to entertain the instant prayer for bail of the accused.

Therefore, the bail prayer of the accused Sri Paran Tudu, stands rejected.

The instant petition for bail of the accused is accordingly disposed of.
