Perused the instant petition and materials in the record.

It is stated that in para No. 06 of the plaint, the date has been wrongly typed as “20-04-2023” in place of “22-01-2024”.

It also stated that in para 08 of the plaint, the cause of action arose on 22-01-2024 but it has been wrongly written as 20-04-2023.

The petitioner states that the above mistakes are purely clerical/typographical in nature and inadvertently it happened.

Ld. Advocate submits that the proposed amendment are very formal in nature and it is required to be allowed for proper disposal of the suit.

On perusal of the record, it is seen that only the erroneous writing of the date as 20-04-2023 in place of 22-01-2024 has occurred and it will not change the nature and character of the present suit.

On the other hand, the proposed amendment is very formal and it is required to be allowed for passing an effective order for final disposal of the suit.

Hence, it is,

**ordered**

the petition, dated : 06-09-2025 under Order VI Rule 17 read with section 151 of the CPC filed on behalf of the petitioner is allowed as prayed for.

The instant petition is accordingly disposed of.
