A petition praying for an order for temporary injunction Under Section 151 of the Civil Procedure Code, 1908 is filed on behalf of the appellants.

Ld. Advocate for the Appellants moves the instant petition.

It is submitted that an order of temporary injunction restraining the defendants from the Sand Block being No. 0115KB009 lying and situated at plot No. 194, J.L. No. 108, Mouza-Kotasole, P.S. Sarenga, Dist. Bankura area 11.78 acres or any part thereof and from dealing with dispossessing of or otherwise encumbering of the said Sand Block till the disposal of the Misc. Appeal is required to be passed, otherwise, the appellants will be highly prejudiced.

At the time of submission, Ld. Advocate for the appellants shows some documents relating to the concerned land.

Considering the submission of the Ld. Advocate for the appellants, this Court finds that if an order of maintaining status quo upon the above property in dispute be passed, then, neither of the parties will be prejudiced and the present purpose of justice to the parties in connection with the disputed property will be sub served, otherwise, a complicated situation will crop up and the matter will be combursome.

So, in order to avoid any kind of complexity upon the property in question, it will be appropriate to direct both the parties to maintain status quo in regard to the property in dispute till date.

Therefore, considering the entire situation involved in the property in question, it is,

Ordered,

that both the parties are directed to maintain status quo as on this day in regard to the property mentioned in the schedule of the instant petition, dated 23-12-2025 Under Section 151 of the CPC filed by the appellants till date.
