1. The present anticipatory bail application has moved by the applicants-accused **Vijay Kumar, Ajit Kumar sons of Ram Lal and Sukhpal son of Ratna** in case FIR No. 105 dated 05.06.2016, under Section 452,354-A. 354, 323,201,509,148 & 149 of IPC Police Station City Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

2. It has been averred in the application that the applicant-saccused have been summoned in the above said case by the court on an application filed under section 319 Cr.P.C. Initially, an inquiry was held by the Investigating Agency and applicants were declared as innocent. They are innocent and have not committed any offence. The applicant

Vijay Kumar was granted benefit of bail by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in criminal appeal no.1366 of 2019 vide Order dated 11.09.2019(copy annexed) and the applicants Sukhpal and Ajit Kumar were granted the concession of bail by the Hon;ble High Court of Punjab and Haryana vide Order dated 14.03.2019 passed in CRM-M- 52544-2018(copy annexed). They have already challenged the order of summoning under section 319 of Cr.PC in which the Hon'ble High Court has sought the status report(copy enclosed). Hence, they be granted anticipatory bail.

3. Arguments heard and record perused with the able assistance of learned counsel for the applicants/accused and Addl. Public Prosecutor for State.

4. The applicants-accused have been summoned to face trial as an additional accused on an application of the prosecution filed under section 319 Cr.P.C. Their custody is not required for any purpose. Keeping in view above facts and circumstances, bail application is allowed accordingly with the direction to the applicants-accused to appear and surrender before the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate on or before the date fixed in the main trial i.e. 06.10.2025, and in the event of their doing so, they be released on bail on their furnishing of bail bonds in sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount each, as per the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate subject to the following conditions:-

- i) that applicants/accused shall attend the trial court on each and every date of hearing;*
- ii) that applicants/accused will not leave India without prior permission of the court;*
- iii) that applicants/accused shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or any police officer to tamper with the evidence;*

4. If the applicants/accused do not comply with the order, then due to non compliance of the order would amount to dismissal of the application. Copy of this order be sent to the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate forthwith for compliance under the signatures of Reader. Bail application file be consigned to the Record Room, Kapurthala.
