Jugal Kishore Versus State of Punjab

Application filed U/s 439 of Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail.

ORDER:-

1. File put up before me being Vacation Judge. This order of mine shall decide an application for grant of regular bail moved by the present applicant-accused in case FIR No. 151 dated 03.06.2022, under Section 21/61/85 of NDPS Act, Police Station Patran, District Patiala wherein it has been alleged that 3 grams 500 miligram heroine was allegedly got recovered from the bail applicant.
2. Learned counsel for applicant-accused pressed for bail on the ground that the bail applicant has been falsely implicated in this case and he has been in judicial custody since 3.6.2022. Presentation of challan and completion of trial will take time. Learned counsel for the applicants/accused prayed for bail on these grounds.
3. Learned Addl.P.P. for State opposed the bail application by stating that the bail application moved on behalf of the bail applicant was dismissed by the Court and prayed for dismissal of the same.

4. I have heard and have also perused the record of the case. As per the police record the bail applicant was arrested on 3.6.2022 while he was found in possession of 3 grams 500 miligram heroine. The above quantity falls in non commercial category. Presentation of challan and the conclusion of trial would take long time. Section 37 of NDPS Act is not attracted and accused is in custody since 03.06..2022. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the applicant-accused into custody for an indefinite period as pre-trial detention is never considered to be just in the interest of justice.

5. Keeping in view these facts and circumstances, application filed by applicant-accused is hereby allowed and he is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing the bail bonds in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with one surety in the like amount. Copy of this order be placed on remand papers, whereas bail application file be consigned to the record room.
