

NDPS Case No. 65 of 2024

Today is fixed for production and I.O's report.

Accused Majitdul Miya is produced from J.C. through V.C. and remanded to further J.C till 13.02.2025.

A bail petition is also filed on behalf of above accused by Ld. Remand Advocate praying for bail on the ground stated therein.

Ld. PP in charge and the Ld. Remand Lawyer of the accused are present.

Now the bail petition is taken up for hearing.

Heard both sides.

Perused the materials on record and submission.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the accused that he has been falsely implicated in this case and has a permanent residence in the locality. So, necessary order may kindly be passed.

Ld. PP in charge opposes the bail prayer of the accused considering the nature of the offence and investigation is going on.

Having heard the submission of both sides and materials on record as well as case diary, I find that 66 bottles of Phensedyl cough syrup bottles were recovered from the possession of the accused person which appears to be commercial quantity and there are sufficient incriminating materials against the accused person u/s 21(C) of the NDPS Act. Moreover, investigation is in progress and therefore the bail prayer of the accused may not be allowed at this stage.

Under the above circumstance and considering the nature of offence, I am not inclined to enlarge accused on bail at this stage. Hence prayer for bail in respect of accused Majitdul Miya stands rejected.
