On perusal of the case record and the materials on record I find that there are sufficient materials for the offence under section 21(C) of the NDPS Act against accused Ilius Hoque @ Samim Hoque. The substance of accusation for the aforesaid charge is read over and explained to the above accused person to which he plead not guilty and claim to be tried.

Formal charge has been framed separately in detail on a separate sheet and kept with the record.
