ORDER

Applicant Paro Bai filed the present application for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C.

2. Notice of the present bail application was issued to the State and then, the ld. Addl. PP for the State on receipt of notice appeared to contest this bail application.

3. The ld. counsel for the applicant contended that the applicant is falsely implicated in this case. Now, the applicant is in custody since long. Conclusion of trial will take long time. So, the applicant may be released on bail.

4. On the other hand, the ld. Addl. PP for the State argued that

the applicant has committed heinous offence and she cannot be given the benefit of bail. Applicant also misused the concession of bail already granted to her. Therefore, the present bail application may be dismissed.

5. I have heard the ld. counsel for the applicant, the ld. Addl. PP for the State and have perused the record carefully. Perusal of the file reveals that the applicant alongwith others was facing trial before this Court in case bearing FIR No.181 dated 23.12.2013 under Sections 15/22/25 of NDPS Act, 1985 P.S. Sidhwan Bet, Ludhiana. Earlier, the applicant was released on interim bail by the Court of Sh. Sukhdev Singh, the then Ld. Judge, Special Court, Ludhiana. During the course of trial, the applicant had not appeared in this court on 17.05.2017, resulting of which, her bail order, bail bonds and surety bonds were cancelled and forfeited to the State. Then, the applicant was ordered to be summoned through non-bailable warrants. After then, the applicant was produced by the concerned police before this court in execution of her non-bailable warrants on 01.02.2018. On that day, she was taken into custody and she was sent to jail. Besides this, in the present bail application, the applicant has not disclosed the reasons for her absence during above said period, which clearly proves that she has misused the concession of bail already granted to her. So, no ground is made out to allow present application for regular bail. Accordingly, the present application for regular is hereby dismissed. The record of this bail application be attached with the main case file.
