Order no. 92 dated 11.08.2026

1. Today is fixed for production of accused person nos. 1 & 13 and submission of report by the Superintendent, Presidency Correctional Home.
2. Accused person no. 1) Sanjay Kr. Surekha is produced from the J/C in physical mode.
3. Received one forwarding letter along with applications to stand surety and bail bond and a server copy of order dated 06.08.2026 passed by the Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta in connection with C.R.M. (R) 55 of 2026 from the Court of Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Calcutta vide letter no.3350 dated 11.03.2026 stating that Bail Bond has been furnished by the Registered Surety namely Zafar Sultan and Local Surety namely Ramesh Chandra Shaw on behalf of the accused person namely **Anant Kumar Agarwal** and the same was accepted by the Ld. C.J.M. Court at Calcutta.
4. Perused the server copy of order wherein the Hon'ble Court has been pleased to observe as follows:

“Accordingly, the petitioner namely Anant Kumar Agarwal shall be released on interim bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Calcutta subject to the following conditions:

- 1) He shall deposit his passport before the learned trial Court at once.*
- 2) He shall remain at his residence in Kolkata and leave his residence only for the purpose of visiting his doctors, admission to hospital, if so advised and meeting his learned advocates representing him before the Courts within the State.*
- 3) He shall not meet any visitor at his residence except his doctors, counsels and near relatives.*
- 4) In the event he is suggested medical treatment by the doctors beyond the State, permission shall be sought by him in that regard from the learned trial Court.*
- 5) The petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence and intimidate witnesses in any manner whatsoever.*
- 6) The petitioner shall provide his mobile phone number before the learned trial Court and the investigating officer and shall not change the same without prior intimation to the said authorities.*
- 7) He shall be at liberty to appear before the learned trial Court either virtually or through his learned counsel.*

In the event the petitioner fails to comply with any of the conditions stated above, the learned trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel his interim bail in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.”

5. Let the copy of solemn order of the Hon'ble Court be kept with the record.

6. The accused person no. 13) Anant Kr. Agarwal is absent and being represented by a petition u/s 355 of BNSS.
7. Ld. Advocates for accused persons are present.
8. Ld. Special Public Prosecutor representing Enforcement Directorate is present by filing hazira.
9. Ld. Counsel for the accused person no. 13) Anant Kr. Agarwal files a petition along with a Passport bearing no.G4245158 issued at Bhagalpur on 11.10.2007 valid upto 11.10.2017 (expired) in the name of Anant Kumar Agarwal in compliance with the order of the Hon'ble Court and prays for keeping the same in the Custody of this Court.
10. Perused the same and let the petition be kept with the record.
11. Let the Passport bearing no.G4245158 issued at Bhagalpur on 11.10.2007 valid upto 11.10.2017 (expired) in the name of Anant Kumar Agarwal be sent to the Sheristeder of the CJM, Calcutta establishment for keeping the same in safe custody.
12. Received one medical report in respect of the accused person namely Sanjay Kumar Sureka along with a forwarding letter bearing no.7868/IMB dated 10.08.2026 in terms of order no.91 dated 28.07.2026 passed by this Court from the Superintendent, Presidency Correctional Home.
13. Perused the same and let the same be kept with the record.
14. A petition has been filed on behalf of the accused person namely Sanjay Kr. Surekha praying for a direction upon the Superintendent, Presidency Correctional Home for production of this accused person in physical mode on the ground stated therein.
15. Perused the same. The Accused has already been produced today on physical mode and he is stated to be suffering from various ailments. He should not be produced physically without a specific reason. Hence, such petition stands rejected.
16. To-date i.e. on 18.08.2026 for S/R, A/D, appearance and production of the accused persons and hearing on the point of cognizance.
17. The accused person no.1 be remanded to J.C. till 18.08.2026.
18. Let a copy of this order be sent to the Superintendent, Presidency Correctional Home for information.
19. Let a copy of this order be forwarded to the Investigating Officer through the Ld. Special Public Prosecutor for information.
