State Vs. Kulwinder

ORDER:

Vide this order, the Court shall dispose of the application to summon the challan and for releasing the Motorcycle bearing registration No.HR07Y-5318 on superdari in challan No.HR9792260620090522 dated 20.06.2026.

2. Applicant has filed the present application stating that he is the owner of aforesaid motorcycle and the same has been taken in possession vide traffic challan No.HR9792260620090522 dated 20.06.2026 by the police of P.S. Pundri. The said motorcycle is standing in the open courtyards of aforesaid police station. The challan is issued ante time and ante dated and falsely implicated the applicant and he will not sell or change the nature of the said vehicle and undertakes that to produce the said vehicle as and when required by the Court. With these submissions, prayer for releasing the aforesaid vehicle on superdari was made.

3. Report of SHO concerned received which states that they have no objection if the above-said vehicle is released to the registered owner, after furnishing surety bonds or depositing the

challan amount. Further, qua the vehicle in question a traffic challan No.HR9792260620090522 was issued and amount of Rs.57,000/- is pending for clearance.

4. Arguments heard & case file perused.

5. Therefore, keeping in view, the facts and circumstances, application stands allowed subject to furnishing superdginama in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount on usual terms and to the satisfaction of the SHO concerned with the condition that the superdar shall not change the shape, colour etc. of the same and shall not dispose of the said vehicle in any manner till final decision of this case and shall produce the same before the court or the police as and when required. **The vehicle will only be released upon clearance of payment of Challan No. HR9792260620090522 dated 20.06.2026.** The SHO concerned is directed to take all the requisite documents of the said vehicle into police possession and to release the said vehicle in question to the applicant against proper identification and verification if not required in any other case.

6. Further, SHO is directed to take photographs of the said vehicle from all angles before releasing it on superdari in pursuance of the directions in this regard issued by the **Hon'ble**

Supreme Court of India in case of Sunderbhai Ambalal Versus State of Gujarat (2002)10 SCC 283.

7. Copy of this order be sent to concerned SHO for compliance. The SHO is directed to satisfy himself regarding ownership of the said vehicle before releasing the superdari. **The application is accordingly disposed of.** Papers be tagged with the FIR.
