Ld. counsel for the applicant has informed the Court that the
petition preferred by the applicant against the order dated 15.10.2020 passed by
this Court has now been listed before Hon'ble High Court of Delhi for
03.03.2022.

Consequently, the present matter be again listed on **10.03.2022** for
awaiting the outcome of the petition pending before Hon'ble High Court of Delhi.
