Today is fixed for production and I.O.'s report.

Accused Md. Salam Mia is produce from J.C. and remanded to further J.C till 04.12.2024.

A bail petition is filed on behalf of accused Md. Salam Mia praying for bail on the ground as stated therein.

Ld. PP in charge and the Ld. Lawyer of the accused are present.

Now the bail petition is taken up for hearing.

Heard both sides.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the accused that he has been falsely implicated in this case and has a permanent residence in the locality. So, he may be granted bail in any terms and conditions.

On the contrary Ld. Special PP for NCB opposes the bail prayer considering the nature of offence and the investigation is in progress.

Perused the materials on record and submission.

Having heard the submission of both sides and materials on record as well as case diary, I find that these are sufficient incriminating materials for the alleged offence u/s 22(c) of the NDPS Act where about 990 gm amphetamine like substance were seized which appeaser to be commercial quantity. Apart from that investigation is in progress as final report has not yet been submitted. Therefore bail prayer of the accused may not be allowed.

Considering all aspects and nature of offence, I am not inclined to enlarge accused on bail at this stage. Hence prayer for bail in respect of accused Md. Salam Mia stands rejected.
