BAIL ORDER

1. This order of mine shall dispose of regular bail application moved by the aforesaid applicant-accused in this case bearing FIR No.0019 of 10.02.2022, U/s 18/21/27/29/61/85 NDPS Act, PS Jhunir, Mansa.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant-accused has argued that applicant-accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case.

Nothing incriminating was recovered from his possession. The allegations levelled by the prosecution are false and concocted one. He was arrested on 10.02.2022 and since then, he is in judicial custody and is no more required for further investigation. The presentation of challan is likely to take some time. On the above said submissions, it has been prayed that applicant/accused be released on regular bail.

3. Upon notice, Learned Additional Public Prosecutor appeared for State and opposed the bail application on the ground that the offence committed by the accused is serious in nature and he is not entitled for concession of regular bail.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the applicant-accused, learned Additional PP for the State and have gone the police record carefully.

5. As per the FIR, 12.50-gm opium was recovered from the conscious possession of the applicant-accused. He is in custody since 10.02.2022. Alleged quantity of opium recovered from the possession of present accused falls in non commercial quantity. Applicant-accused is not required for further investigation of the case. The presentation of challan and its disposal thereof is likely to take considerable time. No useful purpose will be served by detaining the accused behind the bars. Therefore, applicant-accused is ordered to be released on bail in this case on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount subject to the following conditions that:-

1. He shall appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing;

2. He shall not leave India without prior permission of the court;
3. He shall not tamper with the evidence of prosecution.
6. The bail application is allowed accordingly. Police record be returned. File be attached with the remand papers.
