ASI Jarnail Singh No.262/R, posted at Police Post Purkhali
has appeared and suffered a separate statement that the applicant-accused
has joined the investigation in the present case as per order dated
09.10.2025 and he has handed all the documents required by the police in
the present case. Now there is no need to take him in custody as nothing is
recovered from him.

In view of the statement of ASI Jarnail Singh, the interim
bail granted to applicant-accused vide order dated 09.10.2025 is made
absolute. Police file be returned. File be consigned to the record room.
