**Proceedings conducted through Hybrid Mode.
Contested Challan received from the Virtual Traffic Courts web portal. Let it be verified and
registered.**

1. The cognizance of the offence is already taken by the virtual court and fine was proposed for summary disposal of case. The violator has exercised option to contest the challan on web portal of virtual traffic courts and the challan is transferred to this court for further adjudication as per law.

2. At this stage, accusation is explained to the violator in vernacular language. He has submitted that he wishes to plead guilty for the offence u/s 183 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988. He is apprised about the consequences of pleading guilty and the fact that he can be convicted for the offence. He has submitted that he understand the consequences and wants to plead guilty.

3. Keeping in view the plea of guilt of offence by the violator, violator **is convicted for offence u/s 183 MV Act.**

4. In view of the facts and circumstances and taking a lenient view, the convict is admonished for the offence U/s 183 MV Act.

5. Further, convict is directed to Pay Rs. 700/- as prosecution cost U/s 5 of Probation of Offenders Act, 1958. The same should be deposited as fine on the Web Portal of the court i.e. <https://pay.ecourts.gov.in>.

5. Violator is directed to pay the fine amount of Rs. 700/- on the web portal of the court i.e. <https://pay.ecourts.gov.in>.

6. The convict submits that online payment of the fine amount has been paid on behalf of the convict.

7. Online payment of fine has been received dated 29.05.2026 for a sum of Rs. 700/- and the same is updated in CIS as well. Accordingly, challan stand disposed off. Order be uploaded on CIS.

8. Original Documents, if any, with the Traffic Circle be returned to the rightful owner as per rules.

Challan is disposed off.
