ORDER

1. Vide this application under Section 482 B.N.S.S, applicants-
accused have sought pre-arrest bail in the aforesaid complaint.
2. Notice of the application was given to complainant, however,
the same has been received back with the report of affixation.
3. It has been contended by learned counsel for the applicants-

accused that applicants-accused, along with co-accused, were ordered to be summoned vide order dated 16.04.2026 by the learned SDJM, Khadur Sahib, to face trial under Section(s) 420,120-B,323,341,506 IPC, in a criminal complaint filed by respondent-complainant. It is further contended that applicants-accused have not committed any alleged offence and that they are innocent. It is therefore, submitted that applicants-accused are ready to join the proceedings before the learned trial Court, therefore, interim protection may be granted to the applicants-accused.

4. Trial Court record has been received. Perusal of the same reveals that applicants-accused along with co-accused were ordered to be summoned vide order dated 16.04.2026 by the Court of Ms. Monika Chouhan, learned SDJM, Khadur Sahib, to face trial under Sections 420,120-B,323,341,506 IPC in the aforesaid complaint. As is reflected from the recent zimini order dated 25.05.2026, fresh notice to applicants-accused was ordered to be issued for 30.07.2026.

5. Since the applicants-accused have been summoned to stand trial in a complaint case and the matter pertains to the agreement to sell, as such, their custodial interrogation would not be required. The process is issued only to secure their presence in the trial Court, as such, applicants-accused are directed to surrender before the learned Trial Court within 10 days, in which event, the learned Trial Court shall admit the applicants-accused to bail to its satisfaction subject to the conditions incorporated under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S. and any further conditions that may be imposed by

learned Trial Court.

6. With these observations, the present bail application stands disposed of. Record be returned, along with, copy of this order. Bail application file, complete in all respects, be consigned to the record room.
