ORDER

1. Present petition has been filed by petitioner seeking regular bail under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for the alleged commission of offences as mentioned above.
2. Upon notice, learned Additional P.P put in appearance on behalf of respondent-State and contested the bail application.
3. It is submitted by learned counsel for petitioner that petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He has not committed any offence. Petitioner is in custody since 31.05.2022. Conclusion of investigation and presentation of challan

shall take sufficient long time and no purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for indefinite period, so, he may be admitted to regular bail.

4. On the other hand, learned Addl.P. P. submitted that the allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature. If the petitioner is released on bail, he can induce or threaten the prosecution witnesses. At the end, he prayed for dismissal of bail application.

5. I have considered the contentions of learned counsel for petitioner as well as Ld. Addl. Public Prosecutor and also perused the record.

6. As per the contents of FIR so registered on the statement of one Ravinder Sareen son of Dharampal Sareen with the allegations that on 12.05.2022, at about 6.15 p.m, his wife Rajni Sareen alongwith his daughter Ritika Sareen had been going to buy grocery items on scooter bearing No. PB-18-U-0522 and when they reached near Grand Way-2 Hotel, two unknown persons came from behind and they snatched 8 grams gold chain from neck of Ritika Sareena and escaped on motorcycle and person Gurdeep Singh Kahlon identified two of them and one of whom was Sonu DJ Wala.

7. The allegations against accused-applicant has been quite serious. He has been identified at the spot. His name specifically in the FIR to be alleged assailant alongwith one unknown person. It is

stated that three other cases are pending against him of the same nature. So, keeping in view the seriousness of allegations, this court does not intent to grant regular bail to the accused-applicant as if he is released on bail, there would be every possibility that he will tamper with evidence and will influence the prosecution witnesses as well. Hence, present bail application is hereby dismissed. Police record be returned. Record of present bail application be consigned to Record Room.
