Record is put up today on the prayer of Ld. Advocate for the custody accused Pramesh Manger @ Parmesh Manger.

An intimation is filed on behalf custody accused person namely Pramesh Manger @ Parmesh Manger along with download copy of bail order dated 02.07.2025 of the Hon'ble High Court at Jalpaiguri in connection with CRM (NDPS) 250 of 2025 being supported by an affidavits regarding genuinity of the order.

Ld. PP in charge and the Ld. Lawyer of the accused person are present.

Heard both sides.

I have perused the petition along with bail order of the Hon'ble Court as well as Case record and submission.

It appears from the order dated 02.07.2025 of The Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta in the Circuit Bench at Jalpaiguri in CRM (NDPS) 250 of 2025 that The Hon'ble Court has been pleased to pass an order that “..... *The petitioner namely Pramesh Manger @ Parmesh Manger be released on bail upon furnishing bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only), with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Cooch Behar subject to condition that he shall not leave the jurisdiction of Mekhliganj P.S. and shall furnish the address where he shall henceforth reside before the learned trial Court, investigating officer and the Officer in charge of the concerned P.S under whose jurisdiction he shall presently reside. The petitioner shall appear before the learned trial Court on every date of hearing fixed by the learned trial Court and shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.*

In the event the petitioner fails to adhere to any of the conditions as stated above without justifiable cause, the learned trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.”

In view of the order of the The Hon'ble Court mentioned above, let the petition along with the copy of order be kept with the record.

In compliance of direction of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta mentioned above one Rinu Manger the sister of above accused has submitted an affidavit along with her Aadhaar card stating that the accused will reside at the house of Harekrishna Barman, s/o Nripendranath Barman in 147, Bhotbari, Mekhliganj PS, Dist. Cooch Behar, West Bengal. Let it be kept with the record.
