Complaint presented today. It be registered. Statement of complainant recorded today in the court and thereafter he has closed his preliminary evidence. During preliminary evidence complaint has reiterated all the allegations as contained in the complaint vide his sworn affidavit Ex. CW-1/A. He has also tendered in evidence and proved all the requisite documents Ex. C-1 to Ex. C6. Heard. On the basis of allegations as contained in the complaint, affidavit and aforementioned documents, this court is convinced that prima facie case is made out against the accused for commission of offence falling under Section 138 of NI Act. The detailed expression of the opinion is avoided as it is no longer necessary in view of the observations of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in **U.P. Pollution Board Versus Mohan Meekan 2000(2) RCR 421** and reiterated recently in **Dv. CCI & E Versus Roshan Lal Aggarwal 2003(2) RCR (Crl.) 110(SC).** Accordingly, accused be summoned through speed post/registered post as well as ordinary process for 18.04.2019 on filing of PF of Rs. 50/- and copy of complaint. Dasti summons be issued as well at request.
