Present bail application has been moved by applicant/accused named above, seeking regular bail, on the grounds that he was released on regular bail and regularly appearing in the Court on every date of hearing. On 29.08.2022, he was suffering from very high fever, unable to come present due to health condition and was unable to contact his counsel. Consequently, his bail order was cancelled and bonds were forfeited to the State, followed by issuance of non-bailable warrants.

2. Learned counsel for applicant submitted that applicant is in custody since 03.10.2022, having voluntarily surrendered in the Court. He further submitted that absence of the applicant was not intentional rather, due to high fever and there is absence on only one date.

3. On the other hand, learned Addl. PP for State, submitted that the applicant has misused the concession of bail and due to his absence, proceedings of the case were stalled.

4. Heard. Record perused. Applicant/accused absented from the proceedings on 29.08.2022. However, he voluntarily surrendered in this Court on 03.10.2022 on the very next date fixed in the main trial and since then, he is in custody. His such conduct in surrendering in the Court of his

own with promptitude, is liable to be viewed in his favour. Otherwise also, he is in incarceration since the above said date, which might have taught him a lesson for remaining absent from the lawful proceedings. Conclusion of trial will take its own time. No useful purpose would be served by keeping this accused behind the bars for an indefinite period, particularly, when he is ready to comply with all the terms and conditions of bail. Accordingly, applicant/accused is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of **Rs.1,00,000/-** with one surety of the same amount.

5. Record of this bail application be annexed with the record of trial file pending in this Court.
