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ORDER

The brief facts of the case, which require consideration for disposal of the present bail application are that present FIR has been lodged on the ground that applicant-accused Ramandeep Kaur has been nominated under Section 29 of NDPS Act on the basis of confessional statement of her co-accused Sukhjait Singh, vide DDR No.19 dated 20.08.2021. No recovery has been effected from accused-applicant. 1020 Alpream-0.5 tablets, had been recovered from possession of co-accused Sukhjait Singh. Now, apprehending her arrest, the accused-applicant has filed the present bail application.

2. I have heard the learned counsel for the applicant-accused as well as learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

3. Present FIR was lodged against Sukhjait Singh @ Soni. From his possession, 1020 Alpream-0.5 tablets had been recovered. On

the basis of statement of Sukhjit Singh @ Soni, applicant-accused Ramandeep Kaur has been nominated under Section 29 NDPS Act. As per case of police, accused Sukhjit Singh @ Soni had told the police during investigation that the tablets recovered from him were given by applicant-accused Ramandeep Kaur and Soni son of Meet Singh. In the considered opinion of this court, presence of the applicant-accused is required in this case to complete investigation, therefore, no useful purpose would be served by declining pre-arrest bail to her, particularly when she can be directed to join the investigation. Resultantly, the applicant-accused is directed to join investigation by presenting herself before Investigating officer and in the event of her arrest, she be released on interim bail on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of Investigating/Arresting Officer. The applicant-accused shall also abide by all the terms and conditions as specified in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

Now to come up on 24.09.2021, for awaiting the outcome of investigation.
