This is an application U/S 483 BNSS filed by accused/petitioner **Kamal Das**, the resident of Matalpara, P.O. Rangdhamali, P.S. Kotwali, Dist. Jalpaiguri, in connection with Alipurduar P.S. Case No.242/2026 dt. 30.05.26, u/s 303(2)/317(2) of BNS, read with Section 21 of Mines & Minerals Act, corresponding to G.R. Case No.1225/2026.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the petitioner that petitioner is the driver. All the necessary seizure has already been made. Hence he may be released on bail.

Ld. Advocate for the accused submitted that no bail application has been filed or pending before the higher Court.

Ld. P.P has submitted that necessary order may be passed.

Perused the case record as the case diary.

It appears that the case is initiated by the S.I of Police. All the necessary seizure has already been made. Considering the extent of complicity and the materials on record including the case diary, I am of the view that the petitioner/accused **Kamal Das** may be released on bail by furnishing bond of **Rs.5,000/-** with two sureties of **Rs.2,500/- each**, subject to the satisfaction of Learned CJM, Alipurduar,
