**ORDER**

1. This order of mine shall disposed of an application moved by the counsel on behalf of applicant/accused Balkar Singh.
2. It is argued that initially FIR No. 177 dated 27.10.2024 Police Station Lehra was registered against he accused. While he was in custody in said case 08 more FIRs got registered against him. The accused is innocent and not committed any offence. He is falsely implicated in the present FIR. The accused was arrested by police on 05.12.2024 and since then he is judicial lockup. The applicant undertake to appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing. The applicant is ready to furnish the bail bonds and surety bonds before the Court and undertakes to abide by the other directions of this Court. Along with this application affidavit of Chamkaur Singh who is son of applicant/accused Balkar Singh @

Jamma is also annexed who submitted through his affidavit that this is the first bail application of the accused/applicants and no such or similar application for bail is pending. The learned counsel for the applicants/accused prayed that the accused may be admitted on bail.

**3. The learned APP for the State raised oral contention that in case accused released on bail then he will misuse concession of bail. He prayed this bail application may be dismissed.**

**4. This court has carefully considered the contention raised from both the sides and record.**

**5. In the present case, the applicant/accused is booked for an offence punishable under Sections 303(2) Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita. The present FIR was got registered at the instance of complainant against unknown person. The complainant stated that the towers of Airtel company and two RRU from Airtel Anjana Company along-with accessory stolen. While applicant/accused was in custody in FIR No. 177 dated 27.10.2024 Police station Lehra he alongwith co-accused was implicated in present case. No recovery is effected from the accused. The completion of investigation, presentation of challan and culmination of trial will take sufficient time. The applicant/accused arrested on 05.12.2024 in present case. No purpose will be served by keeping him behind the bar. As per legal doctrine bail is rule and jail is exception. After carefully considering the facts of the present case, the accused is admitted to bail in FIR no. 180 dated 27.10.2024 under Section 303(2) Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita PS : Lehra on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of**

**Rs.50,000/-** with one surety in the like amount with the following conditions:-

1. that he/they shall attend the court proceedings on each and every date of hearing and shall not absented himself;
2. that he/they shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected;
3. that he/they shall not leave the Country without the permission of the court;
4. And that he/they shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or tamper with the prosecution evidence.

6. Bail bonds and surety bonds furnished, which are accepted and attested. Release warrants be issued immediately. Further, as per directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SMWP (Criminal) No. 4/2021, information of this bail order be sent to the concerned Superintendent Jail Authorities, where applicants/accused are lodged through email for providing information to the applicant/accused. Ahlmad is directed to tag these papers with the remand papers.
