**JASHANDEEP KAUR-YUVRAJ SHARMA VS. STATE OF
PUNJAB**

Present: Petitioners along-with Sh. Sandeep Singh, Advocate.

Statements of petitioners have been recorded. From the statements of petitioners and documents placed on record, it is proved that the petitioners are of legally marriageable age and they have solemnized marriage with each other out of their free will. From the statement suffered by them, it appears that respondent Nos. 4 to 9 are against their marriage and there is imminent threat to their lives. Therefore, I hereby provide interim protection to the petitioners in accordance with directions laid down by Hon'ble High Court in case titled Asha and others versus State of Haryana in CWP No. 6717 of 2009.

Respondent No.3 i.e. SHO, P.S. Dugri, Ludhiana is directed that in case any representation is filed seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioners, the contents thereof be duly verified and if necessary, requisite steps be taken strictly in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the petitioners. It is clarified that this order shall not be treated as a stamp of this court for marriage of the parties or as proof of their date of birth.

Accordingly, instant protection petition is disposed of with a direction that if no action is taken by the police to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, they have the liberty to approach this court to revive this petition by moving an application. File be consigned to the Record Room, after due compliance.
