

Order No. 02 dt. 16.7.24

Today is fixed for production and I.O.'s report.

Accused person namely Salam Miya is produced from P.C. today along with medical check-up documents and remand forwarding report. No further P.C. prayer is found received today. The accused person is now remanded to J.C. till the next date fixed in this case. Issue intermediate custody warrant at once.

One bail petition along with fresh Vokatnama is filed today on behalf of the accused person which bail petition is now taken up for hearing and order.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person submitted that the accused person is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He prayed for bail for the accused petitioner under any terms and conditions.

Ld. P.P. In-charge raised objection to the said prayer for bail.

Heard both the sides. Perused the petition and the record. Considered.

It appears from the materials in the C.D. that accused person is prima facie liable of having committed the offence u/s 22(c) of The NDPS Act relating to carrying of commercial quantity of a psychotropic substance without any supporting document which is a grave offence. The investigation is at an early stage. Hence, considering the above facts and circumstances and nature and gravity of the offence alleged to have been committed by the petitioner, I am not inclined to enlarge the accused person on bail at this stage. Hence, prayer for bail is considered and rejected.
