Supinder Singh Versus State of Punjab

behalf of the State. Record has been produced.

2. Applicant/accused Supinder Singh alias Aman has moved
this application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail, in FIR
No.39 dated 13.04.2021, under Sections 379-B/411 IPC, Police Station
City Dhuri.

3. Heard. Perusal of record reveals that present case has been
got registered on the statement of Priya daughter of Raj Kumar, resident
of Dhuri, wherein she has stated that she is working in LG company on
private basis at Sunami Gate, Sangrur. As usual, on 10.04.2021, at about
7:45 p.m., she went back to her house on foot from bus-stand, Dhuri. At
that time, she was carrying her mobile phone Mark-Vivo V-17. When she
reached the Kothi of Mohit Garg, IPS situated near Ramgarhia
Gurudawara, one Sikh boy came on a motorcycle from her back side and
he snatched her mobile phone and fled away from there on his
motorcycle. After making inquiries, now he came to know that her mobile
phone was snatched by applicant Supinder Singh alias Aman. On the basis
of this statement, present FIR under Section 379-B IPC was registered
against the present applicant. The applicant/accused was arrested in FIR
No.36 dated 12.04.2021 and during interrogation in that FIR, the
applicant got recovered the mobile phone of complainant of the present

case and motorcycle used in the commission of crime. Accordingly, offence under Section 411 IPC was added. After his arrest, now the applicant seeks regular bail, which is opposed by the learned Public Prosecutor for the State, on notice.

4. Perusal of the record reveals that the present case has been registered on the statement of complainant Priya. In this case, alleged recovery of mobile phone of complainant and motorcycle used in the commission of crime has already been effected. The applicant/accused was arrested in this case on 13.04.2021 and since then, he is in custody. The criminal liability of the applicant/accused can only be adjudicated upon the completion of the trial. Challan in this case is yet to be presented. The conclusion of the trial is also likely to take considerable time. The applicant has already been granted regular bail by this Court in FIR No.36 dated 12.04.2021 and FIR No.37 dated 12.04.2021. Applicant/accused Supinder Singh alias Aman cannot be ordered to be detained in custody for an indefinite period. Accordingly, this bail application is also allowed and applicant/accused is ordered to be released on bail, on furnishing his personal bond in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety of the like amount, to the satisfaction of Illaqa/Duty Magistrate. Copy of this order be sent to the Court of Illaqa Magistrate, for compliance. Police record be returned and bail application file be consigned to the record room.
